FALL 2017 SCA EXTENDED EXTRAS PROGRAM DETAILS

- **Class Fee:** Each class is **\$140** for the 8-week session or **\$145 or \$155, if an extra fee applies**. Extra fee for supplies applies to: "Sock It To Me" with Mrs. B (\$5 fee) and Kitchen Science (\$15 fee). Checks are made payable to "Manhasset SCA". Please make individual checks for each child participating.
- **Class Enrollment & Offering:**
 - Classes begin the week of October 16, 2017. All classes are taught by NY State certified teachers.
 - In case of inclement weather, be mindful of district notifications/cancellations.
 - Students may enroll in more than one class.
 - Enrollment is limited. We reserve the right to cancel classes due to lack of enrollment.
 - Classes are filled on a first come first serve basis. You will be notified of your classes via email.
 - There are **no make-ups/refunds** for missed classes after 10/16/17.
- **Transportation**
 - There is no early bus for the morning classes. A late bus is offered on Tuesdays and Thursdays, which departs from Shelter Rock School at 4 pm.
 - Only children of parents who are fully committed to their children riding the late bus on Tuesdays, Thursdays, or both days will be permitted to board the late bus.

Class Descriptions:

Bring Disney to Life! Students will learn all about the magic of Disney through history, art, writing and music. Each week we'll focus on one particular character or play. We will learn songs, incorporate writing within the Disney theme and even learn how to draw some of our favorite characters!

Bringing Literature Alive Through Drama: Children will expand their literary knowledge, boost their fluency, explore the elements of fiction and drama, and get excited about reading while acting out classic stories.

Chess Club: Students of all levels will have the opportunity to play friendly games of chess in a low-stress environment while sharpening their critical thinking, foresight and creativity.

Code Tots: Students will move at their own pace through scaffolded lessons to learn programming concepts in a fun, engaging way and then apply them creatively on multiple computer code applications.

Creative Writing for the Young Writer: In this class we will focus on the art of creative writing. We will choose topics that are of interest to the members of our group. We will publish our final pieces.

Drawing and Painting: Students will sketch, draw and paint onto canvas board and watercolor paper. They will use tempera paint, watercolors, and a selection of drawing tools.

Dynamic Dance: This program will integrate different types of dance such as Ballet, Hip-Hop and Latin Fusion. Each class will consist of a warm up, choreographed dance, and a cool down. We will be using music that is high energy and engaging. All levels welcome.

Fun With Physics: Explore the exciting world of physical science with fun hands-on activities to investigate heat, sound, light, motion, and chemistry.

Give My Regards to Broadway: This class will teach students about the most famous street in NYC, Broadway! Each week we'll focus on one show including Hamilton, Annie, The Sound of Music and so much more! We'll learn about the history and music of these famous shows. Bring your smiles and voices!

Kitchen Science: Students will experiment with common household materials to produce both physical and chemical reactions.

Lego Club: Students will be following directions, building, and creating using Lego pieces.

Lego Engineering: Students will use Legos to design and build simple and complex machines.

MindCraft Code: Create a world of adventure and learning through the use of MineCraft. Students will learn computer programming and how to create innovative and interactive scenes using PowerPoint and their own individual MindCraft character.

Music Composition: Mrs. Faltings' Music Composition Class will teach each student the different components of writing a melody. The students will learn about key signatures, time signatures, harmonic progressions, chords and much, much more! Our goal is to create a class composition by the end of the course, which will be performed for their peers! Come compose with us!

Nature Exploration Club: In this class the children will explore Long Island wildlife and environment. Included in our study will be birds, insects, rocks, native plants, migration, mollusks, butterflies, crickets, clams and trees.

Reading is Magic! Read and discuss books from Kate Egan's "Magic Shop" series and learn a new magic trick every week.

Reader's Theater: Combine children's folktales with theater, using age-appropriate short scripts. Just bring your enthusiasm -- there are no sets, costumes, props, or need to memorize lines!

Sock It To Me! with Mrs. B: Create a sock puppet and take the new friend on an adventure by writing a creative story for them. Create a storyboard, research a setting, plan a plot, and publish an original piece in this new and exciting creative writing class.

Speaking Spanish Through Literature: Students will explore a variety of literature in Spanish while learning to read and speak in Spanish.

Sports and Games: Students will participate in various sports in the gym. At each class a different game will be introduced. Students must wear sneakers to participate.
