A question regarding Mrs. Mitchell, a 6th grade teacher who has been out of school, was asked. Mr. Geczik explained that her plans are to return right after Thanksgiving. She still needs clearance from her doctor. She has been checking in with the 6th grade team regularly.

Sean Adcroft, Coordinator for Instructional Technology and Libraries spoke regarding the Parent Portal.

He explained that the plan in about a year or two is to go paperless. Right now report cards are being mailed home and are also available on the parent portal. The browsers that currently work with the parent portal are Internet Explorer, which is on every PC and some versions of Safari.
